## ***Airbus A320 Jet Training Program\****

### **Course Description**

This 3 week A320 Jet Training Program is an introductory course designed for pilots who want to get hired as an A320 series First Officer, and gain proficiency in the operations of the Airbus Jet, to specific airline standards, prior to completing the airline's own FAA/DGCA/CAA Approved training program. All training is conducted to specific airline standards by highly experienced, current Airbus Airline Instructor Pilots, with emphasis on positive reinforcement and achievement of results. Upon graduation, the crewmember is expected to fly the Airbus to airline standards. Using the A320 training platform, it provides you exceptional training in the following areas:

- "Glass Cockpit" / Electronic Flight Instrument Systems (EFIS)
- Flight Management System (FMS)
- Crew Resource Management (CRM), Crew Coordination
- A320 Aircraft Systems
- A318, A319, A321 Differences (when required)

The Airbus A320 Jet Training Program consists of 2 phases:

- Phase I:** 80 hours self-study program, utilizing computer-based-training (CBT), and a complete set of company provided training materials, including software, manuals, study guides, checklists, posters, and lesson plans, to be conducted from home.
- Phase II:** 40 hours (5 days) of Instruction, including Cockpit Procedures Training (CPT), 20 hours of Simulator flying in a Airbus A320 Advanced FTD, Pre/Post Flight Briefings, Qualification Check-ride, and Graduation Certificate award, conducted on premises.

The pilot candidate will undergo the following process:

- Eligibility pre-screening, conducted by Simulation Standards.
- Formal airline interview, conducted by respective airline.
- Successful completion of this Jet Training Program, and job offer by respective airline.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- FAA Commercial Pilot Certificate, Instrument Airplane, Multiengine Land, Ratings.
- FAA First Class Medical Certificate.
- FCC Restricted Radiotelephone Operators Permit.
- US Citizen with valid US Passport, or appropriate INS/TSA Authorization Documents.
- AS / BS / Masters degree, in Aviation field, preferred.
- FAA Approved 141 / 142, or similar flight training program completion, preferred.

### **Course Cost**

- US\$5,995, payable by credit card, check, money order, or bank wire transfer.
- US\$500 deposit is required to secure class date, and receive all home-study materials, with remaining US\$ 5,495, due prior to start of training.
